INSTALLATION AND SET UP


POWER REQUIREMENTS

Vision.net Touchscreen operates on 24VDC. It is powered through the Touchscreen control PCB (pre-installed on the back of the touchscreen) via an external AC to DC power supply. It may alternatively be powered from a PoE+ (IEEE802.3at) compliant supply, using the RJ45 ethernet connector.

MOUNTING / INSTALLATION

To mount the touchscreen:

- Step 1. For surface and flush mount options, install the back box in the required location.
- Step 2. Fix the bezel in place, using the two supplied screws in position A (the screws are over length to accomodate varying thicknesses when flush mounting)
- Step 3. Connect the required cables to the screen connectors (see "Connecting Power" on page 3).
- Step 4. Mount the touchscreen by inserting the screen assembly into the bezel. Spring tabs on the touchscreen click into slots "B" on the bezel, securing the touchscreen.



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To remove the touchscreen:

Step 1. Insert a nylon spudger (or other similar nylon pry tool) into one of the two slots at the bottom of the installed touchscreen.



WARNING: Do not use a metal screwdriver or any other metal pry tool to remove the touchscreen. Metal can scratch or crack the surface.


Gently pry the bottom edge of the touchscreen Step 2.




Touchscreen removal slots


Surface Mount





CONNECTING POWER

To connect an external power supply from Vision.net network:

- Step 1. Make sure power is disconnected (removed) before connecting power to touchscreen.
- Step 2. Consult wiring diagram and connect to Vision.net/Power Phoenix connector.

To connect an external power supply using PoE+ injector:

- Step 1. Make sure power is disconnected (removed) before connecting power to touchscreen.
- Make PoE+ connection. Step 2.

NETWORK CONNECTIONS

If you are not using PoE+, connect a standard CAT5e cable from the TCP/IP network directly to the RJ-45 port on the touchscreen. If the ethernet jack is used, a static IP address in the same range must be configured for the jack to be active.
