Challenge

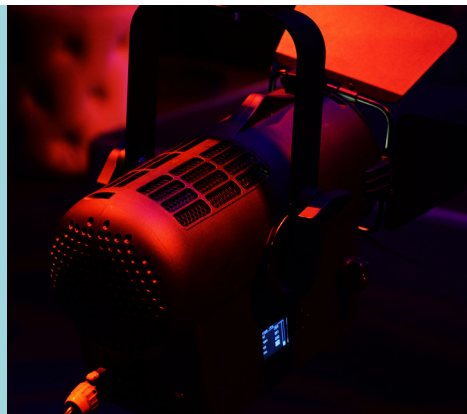
Solution

Because there are multiple portions of a service, a small sanctuary must address a variety of lighting needs. Stage, architectural, and house lighting is combined in a single space, and lighting can shift from live event lighting during the music to a more theatrical style for the rest of the service.



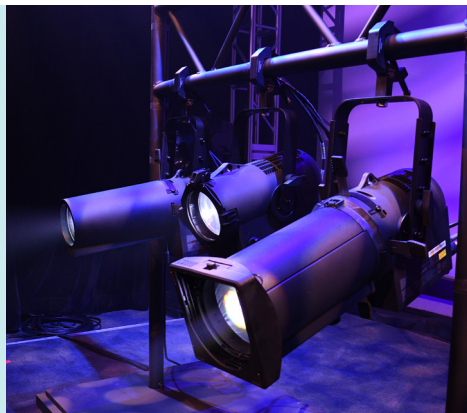
Churches can leverage cost-effective lighting from Vari-Lite with feature sets targeted at small sanctuaries. With powerful, economical luminaires for both event and theatrical lighting and a console designed to do both well, a Vari-Lite lighting system delivers the perfect solution.

In these smaller worship spaces, the fixtures are installed closer to the stage and the congregation, meaning the fixtures must be compact, with excellent output and wide enough throw angles to cover the entire stage despite shorter distances.



VL600 and VL800 Series fixtures offer excellent output and features for small houses of worship. The VL600 Acclaim Zoomspot can be adjusted from a narrow 25° to a wider 50°, while the VL800 EventWash offers a compact moving wash with an automated zoom for stage wash or back lighting.

Smaller sanctuaries often have lower roofs. This brings fixtures closer to the congregation. Because the fixtures are both visible and potentially audible to the parishioners, it's important that they don't distract from the message.



To ensure our fixtures don't become the focus of the service, we include an adjustable fan control, with multiple noise modes. And to ensure the fixtures blend in with any architectural application, Vari-Lite luminaires are available in both black and white body styles.

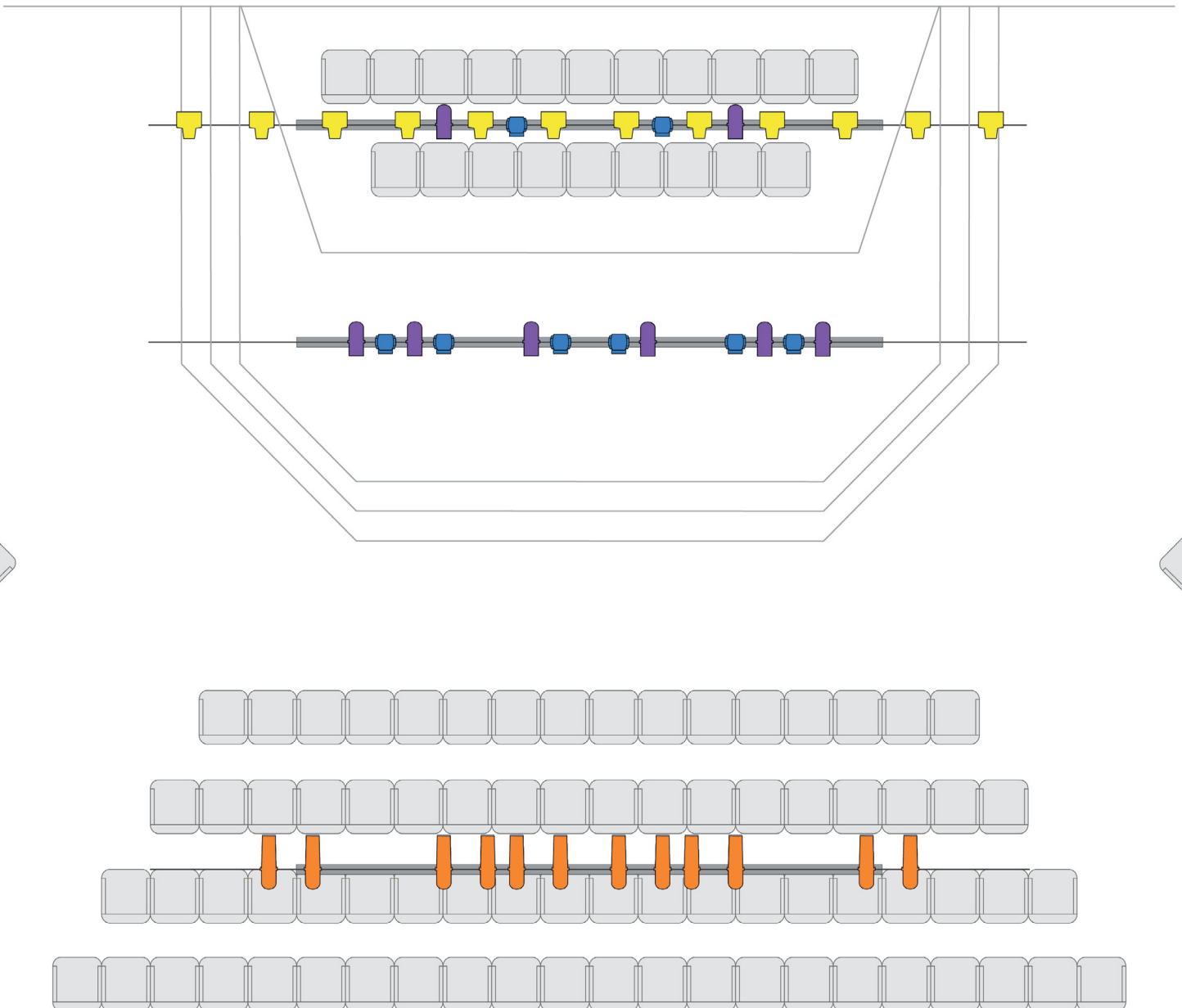
Because lighting systems are typically controlled by volunteer users in small sanctuaries, architectural lighting and show control must be capable and easy to use.



The intuitive FLX S48 Console ensures anyone from a volunteer to the worship pastor can control the lighting with minimal training. And with the Vision.Net architectural control solution, users can control house and stage lighting effortlessly at the push of a button.

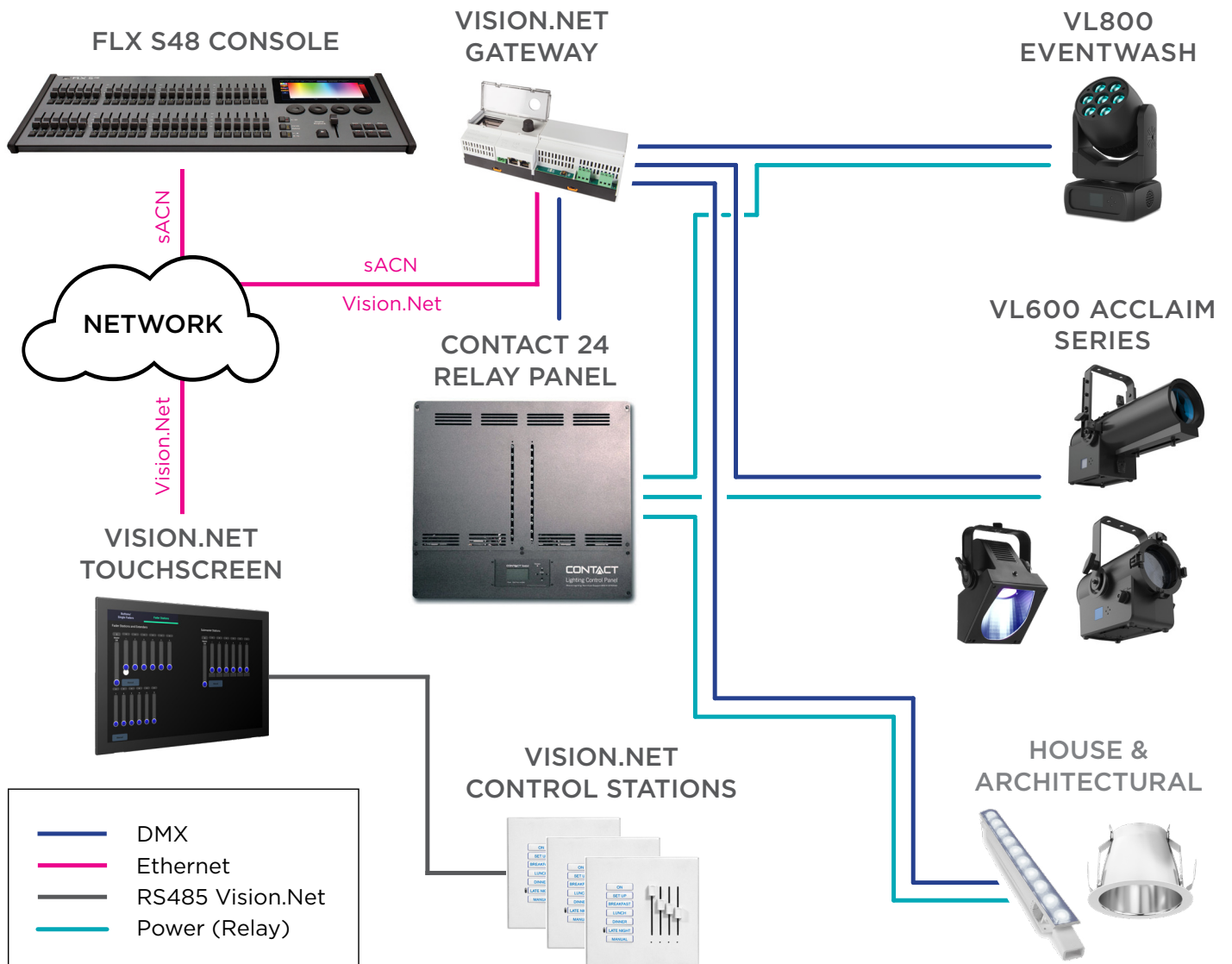

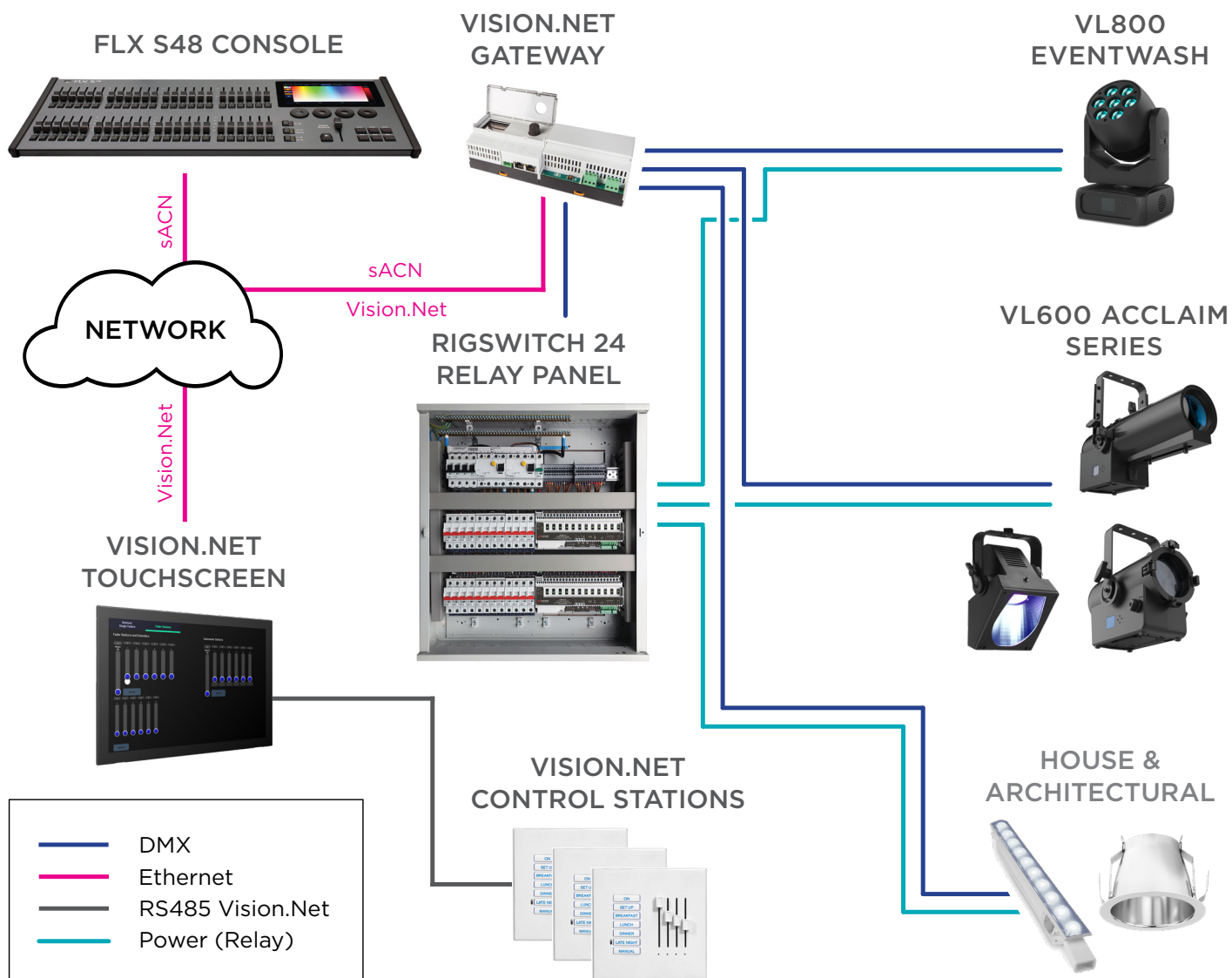
